Mark Feldman is an active performer in the worlds of jazz, Improvised Music and 20th Century Contemporary Music.

Composer John Zorn has included him in many concert and recording projects over the past 10 year including Masada String Trio, Bar Kophfa, film scores, chamber music and Performances of the Game Piece "Cobra"

Before moving to New York City in 1986 Mr. Feldman lived in Nashville Tennessee where he was member of the ensembles that traveled and accompanied country western singers Loretta Lynn and Ray Price.In Nashville as a studio musician he appeared on over 200 Recordings including albums by Johnny Cash, Willie Nelson and George Jones, Jerry Lee Lewis and Television evangelist Jimmy Swaggart.
